We were appointed by a housing association to deal with the structure of the property only. A full fire clean was required to the structure. We had to uplift the vinyl flooring, remove the blown plaster on the ceiling and affected walls. Seal the walls to prevent the soot re-servicing once painted. Paint walls, ceiling, door, skirting boards, 6 cupboard doors. Replace and fit vinyl flooring.
